In my Tribal communities and in recent years, there have been several people that have gone missing or have been murdered. One Tribal member's son has been missing since the summer, and her only resource is to post flyers around the communities and post on Facebook. I often wonder "what if" about our missing and murdered relatives. Although not a final step in reducing the number of our missing and endangered relatives, this event code could help reduce those numbers and is an important step in the process.</p>
