This training is ideal for broadcasters and first responders.

This training offers participants the basics of underwriting in compliance with FCC rules and regulations that can increase revenue for radio stations. Participants will leave with a grounded understanding of underwriting, the ability to write underwriting spots, and knowledge to develop strong internal policies.
